

Purchasable Services

We provide a range of services to support people throughout their rehabilitation journey and welcome your enquiries and referrals.

Our ABI Wellbeing Centres provide group based life-enhancing activities and provide a safe space for brain injury survivors to meet and receive help from our skilled Rehabilitation Assistants. We can also offer 1:1 Support in the home or community, assisting people to regain and retain as much function, independence and quality of life as possible. Having specialist cognitive, emotional/behavioural and executive skills rehabilitation can make a significant difference to relearning practical living skills, developing new approaches to tasks and building confidence post-injury.

To access these services individuals must either be referred and funded through Adult Social Care /Direct Payments/ Health Budgets or will need to self-fund.

ABI Wellbeing Service £60 per day

The service reduces social isolation and loneliness, enabling people to build peer relationships and benefit from social interactions. Importantly, staff are on hand to help attendees with practical challenges, such as changes to benefits, booking health appointments, and understanding letters received.

For family members/supporters, our Wellbeing Service can also provide a much needed and valued break from unpaid caring responsibilities.

We do not provide transport so this must be organised separately.

1:1 Enablement and Independence Service £28 per hour

This service provides intensive and tailored one-to-one Rehabilitation Support to assist brain injury survivors move closer towards their specific personal goals over an agreed period of time. Our highly personalised service can be delivered at the person's home where appropriate or at a suitable community location.

1:1 Specialist Outreach £25 per hour

Some people with acquired brain injury need ongoing expert support to live independently.

Our staff use their expertise to assist people with multiple aspects
of life including managing finances, behaviours, relationships and situations
that could place them at risk. Over an extended period of time people may
become increasingly competent and confident, depending on their
ability to learn new skills.

Employment Support Service Individually designed and costed

This is a new offering, providing people with acquired brain injury and their employers with the expertise and practical guidance they need to facilitate a positive return to work. Following an initial assessment, support provided can include advice on reasonable adjustments, training for colleagues, and workplace strategy assessments.

Additional Information for Referrers

Referrals for our Enablement & Independence, Specialist Outreach and Employment Support Service should be clear in the intended outcomes and time scales to support the delivery of these. Based on our experience, we would recommend a minimum two to three-hour booking for 1:1 services, depending on the needs, wishes and preferences of the individual.
